The meeting was called to order by Dr. Jody Clements.

Minutes: The group approved the minutes of the previous SHAC meeting held on November 6, 2014.

Stroke Scan- Dates for the Stroke Scan Employee program were discussed and procedures performed were introduced to the committee.
