Special Ed. Track & Field Day set for Friday

About 90 students from Ned E Williams, J.L. Everhart, Johnston McQueen, Bramlette and South Ward elementary schools; Judson and Forest Park middle schools and Longview High School will be participating in the district's 2011 Special Education Track and Field Day, slated for Friday at Lobo Stadium.

Events include wheelchair races, assisted walk/run races, dashes, developmental bowling, tennis ball throw, softball throw, shuttle run, standing long jump and tug-of-war. Volunteers from various Longview High School groups will be assisting on this day. Members from the Lobos football team, LHS cheerleaders, student council and Forever Friends will be assisting. Ware's student council members will furnish goodie bags for the student athletes.
