Four Longview High School students named as 2010-11 National Hispanic Recognition Program Scholars

The College Board has selected four Longview High School students as 2010-11 National Hispanic Recognition Program Scholars.

Allyson Castillo, Collin Gonzalez, Carlos Rodriguez and Christine Suggs were among the nearly 5,000 students selected from more than 200,000 students who took the 2009 PSAT/NMSQT/PAA and identified themselves as Hispanic/Latino.

Students recognized by the NHRP are at least one-quarter Hispanic/Latino (based on the program's definition) and have achieved a minimum PSAT/NMSQT/PAA score for their region. All four Longview High School students had GPAs of 3.5 or higher, and were designated as Scholars.

Another important component of the NHRP is that the list of recognized students is distributed to subscribing four-year postsecondary institutions this month. This gives the students an opportunity to hear from colleges that are particularly interested in communicating with academically outstanding students of Hispanic/Latino heritage.
