Action: Consideration and/or approval of entering into performance contracts with charter operators

### **SUBJECT:**

The consideration and/or approval of action to grant campus charters and authorize the superintendent to enter into a performance contract with Longview LEAP and Texas Council for International Studies to operate campuses in Longview ISD.

### **RATIONALE:**

This is the next step in moving the district to district-wide charter partnerships and submitting out application for SB1882 benefits to TEA. The deadline for the benefits application has been moved to April 30, 2020. One of the requirements for benefits is that the district and operating partner have entered into a performance contract.

### **SUMMARY:**

After reviewing the proposals and negotiating contracts, two of the proposed partner organizations were withdrawn from consideration. Through the negotiations, it was determined that TCIS and Longview LEAP would be the most beneficial partnerships for the district.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve the granting of charters and authorize the superintendent to enter into a performance contract with TCIS and Longview LEAP.
