Brief Summary of Discussion on By-Laws for the Bond Oversight Committee

There was lengthy discussion regarding the By-Laws and Guidelines for the Bond Oversight Committee. There was concern on verbiage regarding duties as this is not a paid position and the committee is not overseeing the financial decisions on the bond projects. The oversight committee provides communication. Another comment was that the By-Laws don't go with the Oversight Committee. Matthew Prosser stated that the By-Laws are a starting point that the LISD Board approved at the October 21, 2024 regular board meeting. He stated that we could approve with modifications making sure we are leaning towards oversight not decision-making.

Thomas Norris gave a handout to be noted in the minutes. The following was noted in his handout:

- Get a good contract
- Check BBB
- Low bidder is not always the best
- Look at the workmanship and ask for references
- Ask the time for completion
- The contractors will check on the jobs and materials and be the mediator
- Contractors should be able to get the job started without making a monetary draw and enough work competed to get a draw
- Make sure lumber materials are protected from the weather every day. Also, safety, security and cleanliness.
- Make sure we get quality materials at a competitive price
- What percentage are we paying the architect?
- Estimate time to complete the jobs
- Check the reputation of the contractors
- Make sure there are cameras and lights on materials
- Make sure employees wear proper PPE gear
- Make sure when jobs are completed that they will come back and are agreeable to fix any problems

Matthew Prosser asked for a show of hands for the approval of the By-Laws and Guidelines for the Bond Oversight Committee (with modifications). All approved with a show of hands with none-opposed.
